Sub: Grant of approval u/s 18 of the Right of Children to Free & Compulsory Education Act, 2009 & Rule 11 Sub Rule (4) of Right of Children to Free & Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 and Grant of School Approval Certificate.

Respected Sir/Madam,

On the basis of your application dated 03/09/2025 and the subsequent correspondence with the school and inspection there under, I, Bhaskar Patil, Education Officer (Pri) Zilla Parishad, Ahilyanagar hereby grant approval temporarily for a period of three years i.e. from 01/04/2025 to 31/3/2028 for Std. 1st to Std. 8th in the name of **Shree Ganesh International School**, Korhale Taluka Rahata Dist. Ahilyanagar on following terms-

1. It shall not be mandatory to give extension for the recognition period after Std. 8th or affiliation in any situation.
2. The school shall follow the provisions made in the Children's Right for Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure I) and



Children's Right for Free and Compulsory Education (Maharashtra) Rules, 2011 (Annexure II)

3. The school shall admit the children belonging to the weak and deprived sections nearby the school, in standard I, to the extent of 25% min. of the total strength and shall provide free and compulsory education to those children. Notwithstanding to this, this standard will be followed for the pre-primary standards also.
4. The school shall receive compensation for the children mentioned in para 3 vide section 12(2). The school will be provided a separate bank account for such compensation.
5. The School/institution shall not recover any capitation fees and not insist children or their parents to undergo for any scrutiny.
6. No child shall be denied the admission in the school on the grounds of religion, caste or race or place of birth or any of this and in absence of proof of age.
7. (One) Any child once admitted shall not be kept in the same standard or shall not be removed from the school till the completion of primary education.
(Two) No child should be given physical punishment or mental torture.
(Three) No child shall be required to pass any examination of any board till the completion of primary education.
(Four) Every child having completed the primary education shall be given a certificate vide Rule 23.
(Five) The physically challenged/special pupils shall be included as per the provisions of the Act:
(Six) The teachers having min. qualification as prescribed under the Section 23(1) of the Act shall be appointed; Notwithstanding this, the teachers having not qualified on the date of beginning of the Act shall be required to obtain such a qualification within 5 years.
(Seven) The teachers shall fulfill their duties as given in the Section 24(1) and
8. School shall follow the syllabus prescribed by competent authority.



9. The School shall admit such number of students as per the facilities available in the section 19.

10. Following facilities were available in the School during last inspection as specified in the Section 19 of the School Act.

11. The classes or standards not approved cannot be run in the premises of school or elsewhere.

12. The building of the school or other constriction or playground shall be used only for education or skill development purposes.

13. The school is being run by as society registered under the Societies Registration Act. 1860 (21 of 1860) or the Maharashtra Public Trusts Act, 1950.

14. The school is not run for the financial or other benefit of any person or group of persons.

15. The accounts of the school should be audited by a chartered accountant and proper audit statements be made. A copy of each statement shall be sent to the Education Officer every year.

16. The approval code for your school is **(10 018 34 089)**. Kindly mention the same while making any correspondence with this office.

17. Any such report or information as will be required by the Director of Education or Dist. Education Officer shall be provided by the school or the instructions of the local authority shall be followed for compliance of the conditions of approval or to remove the lacunae in the functioning of the school.



18. Renewal should be ensured, if any, regarding the registration of the school.
19. Other conditions are annexed herewith vide Annexure III.
20. If registration with the Office of Public Charitable Trust is incomplete, change report is not submitted, audit report is not submitted and any other deficiency, it shall be complied with and Copy of Schedule I issued by this office shall be made available in the school.
21. If there is dispute within the society, the charge shall be given to the body finally adjudicated upon by the Asst. Charity Commissioner, Ahilyanagar as per Schedule I or to the Administrator duly appointed by this office.
22. It shall be mandatory for the school to comply with the Govt. directives given vide circular, orders and procedure issued from time to time.
23. It shall be mandatory to make compliance of the Maharashtra Self-financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012 (Act 1 of 2013).
24. Compliance with all the provisions therein shall be mandatory.
25. Govt. permission is given in the name of '**Shree Ganesh International School**', for English medium at the location- Korhale Taluka Rahata Dist. Ahliyanagar. In future no change would be allowed for medium and location or any such change is made by School, its recognition shall automatically stands cancelled. So also from this date school shall be treated run unauthorizedly.
26. It shall be the responsibility of school to obtain U-DIAS No. from the officers. It shall also the responsibility of school to upload information about each student in the system, update it, to link it with Aadhar, to submit application in prescribed form for U-DIAS certificate, to take all steps under 'Progressive Educational Maharashtra'
